4x6 unfinished wood frame
Shrink plastic
Felt Branch
Small Flowers
Mod Podge

TOOLS

Hot Glue
X-acto knife
Sand paper

project instructions

ALTERED FRAME

STEP 1: Adhere patterned paper to frame using Mod Podge as your adhesive.

STEP 2: Once that has dried you can also apply a layer of Mod Podge over the top of the paper to get a nice protective coating.

STEP 3: After the paper and the protective coating has dried, lay the frame paper side down on a cutting table and use an X-acto knife to trim away any excess paper around the frame.

STEP 4: Turn the frame back over and use the X-Acto knife to trim around the inside of the photo frame area.

STEP 5: Use the sand paper to sand the edges of the frame.

STEP 6: Stamp the butterfly image onto the shrink plastic and color in the pattern before baking.

STEP 7: Adhere felt branch to frame

STEP 8: Position the shrink butterflies and flowers where desired. Use a small dot of hot glue to to adhere these items to the frame.

STEP 9: Add your title using the chipboard letters and sand letters for a distressed look.
